One of the Creative Alliance's longest-running programs, the Saturday morning Life Drawing class has been meeting every week for over a decade and provides artists of all ages the regular and cost-effective opportunity to continue their individual studies of the human figure. For the past few years this class has been offered in collaboration with Artist's Housing and Gallery 1448. Every year this class culminates in an exhibition of the drawings produced through the class, and this year the Creative Alliance is proud to host the exhibition in its Amalie Rothschild Gallery. This exhibition will feature over a dozen of the community's strongest draftsmen and draftswomen in a show utterly devoted to the beauty and complexity of the human form.

Artists are being asked to submit artwork that demonstrates a commitment to drawing from the live model, and has been produced at or inspired by the Saturday morning Life Drawing Workshop. Please see eligibility requirements listed below.

Important Dates

- Aug 20-21: Artwork delivery (11am-7pm)
- Aug 24: Reception, 6:00 – 8:00 PM
- Sep 14: Artwork retrieval, after Life Drawing Class

Eligibility

- Artist must have attended Life Drawing class at Gallery 1448 and/or Creative Alliance
- Artwork must not exceed 48 inches in width, height, or depth including frame
- Artists may submit up to 3 works
- Artwork works must have been created within the past two years
- Artworks must be dropped off and ready to hang
- Late artworks will not be accepted

Procedures Form

1. Artwork Drop-Off

All work must be delivered and ready for installation on **August 20-21** between 11:00 AM and 7:00 PM at Creative Alliance (3134 Eastern Ave. Baltimore, MD 21224).

2. Hanging Requirements

All artwork must be framed with wire and received ready for installation on **August 20-21**. For artworks unable to be framed, artists are responsible for attaching the proper hanging equipment to artwork prior to drop off. Artwork should not exceed 4 feet in height or width or weigh over 40 pounds unless preapproved by exhibition curator.

3. Publicity

All artists may be listed on event invitations, catalogs, and signage; in press releases; on Creative Alliance's website exhibit calendar. All accepted and approved artworks are eligible for marketing purposes including: event flyers, postcards, save the date invitations, sponsorship forms, and online event RSVPs.

4. Commission and Payment

The final sale price for each artwork sold will be divided 60/40 between the artist (60%) and Creative Alliance (40%). When establishing artwork value artist should choose an amount he/she/they are comfortable with, given the 60/40 split with Creative Alliance. **Upon request, Visual Arts Curator will advise on pricing of artwork.** Artists may choose to increase the amount donated to Creative Alliance if they desire. Artists will receive the name of any purchaser and a check for their portion of the sale no later than 30 days after the end date of the exhibition.

5. Insurance and Liability

CA will arrange insurance so that, should damage or loss occur, the artist/lender will be fairly compensated. The Artist/lender will assign proper values to the Property based on fair market value, supported by comparable property sales and/or inventory records. Signature acts to consign work to CA immediately, and CA agrees to assume wall-to-wall insurance coverage for the full net price of the below-mentioned work for the full duration of the consignment once artworks are delivered and installed.

6. Artwork Pick-Up

Artist must pick up artwork within timeframe of *Artwork Retrieval Date* listed or notify Creative Alliance if you will be late. Unless previous arrangements have been made, artwork placed in storage after announced *Artwork Retrieval Dates* will be subject to a fine of **\$10.00 per piece, per week**. Work left in storage longer than two (2) weeks shall become property of Creative Alliance and may be disposed of or used for fundraising purposes. There are no exceptions.
